## **Coptic Lesson 3:** Five New Coptic Letters

In lesson one, we learned the letters that look and sound like English letters:

We also learned three letters that look like English letters but are pronounced differently:  $H p \chi$ 

In lesson two, we learned Seven New Coptic Letters:  $\Gamma \ \lambda \ \Lambda \ \Pi \ \delta \ \chi \ \omega$ Now let us learn a few more Coptic Letters. Below is the shape of the letter (in Caps and small), its name, and its pronunciation Note: not all pronunciation rules will be included, just the basic ones, to avoid confusion.
