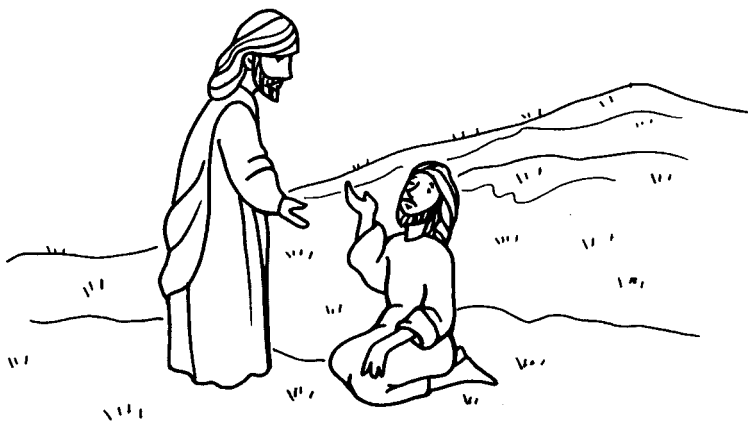
No one wanted them around. But the Lord Jesus Christ was not afraid of the sick
