n this blessed month of Koiahk, we celebrate the commemoration, martyrdom, and departure of some of our honorable saints. Some of them are:

Koiahk 3: Entrance of Saint Mary into the Temple in Jerusalem

- **Koiahk 4:** Martyrdom of St. Andrew the Apostle, the brother of St.Peter Departure of the Holy Prophet Nahum
- Koiahk 7: Martyrdom of St. Barbara and St. Juliana
- Koiahk 8: Departure of St.Samuel the Abbot (Abba Samuel the Confessor)
- Koiahk 11:Commemoration of the Honorable Angel Michael, the Archangel
- Koiahk 12: Commemoration of St. John the Confessor
- Koiahk 14: Martyrdom of Saints Simeon of Menouf, Abba Hor and Abba Mina the Elder
- Koiahk 17: Commemoration of the Departure of St. Luke
- Koiahk 21: Commemoration of the Virgin Mary, the Mother of God Martyrdom of St. Barnabas, one of the Seventy Apostles
- Koiahk 22: Commemoration of the Archangel Gabriel
- Koiahk 23:Departure of David, the Prophet and King
  - Departure of St. Timothy, the Anchorite
- Koiahk 24: Birth of St. Takla-Haymanot, the Ethiopian

And finally at the end of the blessed month of Koiahk on the 29<sup>th</sup>, we celebrate the **Glorious Feast of the Nativity** (Christmas) of our Lord Jesus Christ. On the Glorious Feast of the Nativity, we participate with the Lord's angels in their rejoicing and praise, "*Glory to God in the highest, And on earth peace, goodwill toward men*" (Luke 2:14).

We have in our Coptic Orthodox Church a very special fast before the celebration of the Glorious Feast of the Nativity. The fast of the Nativity is forty-three days in reference to the following:



- 1. The forty day fast of Moses for receiving the "Ten Commandments" in the land of Sinai (Ex 24:18).
- 2. The three day fast in commemoration of the miracle of moving "EL MOKATTAM" mountain.

The last thirty days of this fast fall in the Coptic month "Koiahk" during which we enjoy singing special hymns, "joy hymns", of this month.
