We are writing to you on behalf of the Coptic Orthodox Diocese of the Southern United States. As you may know, in 2006, the Diocese purchased fifteen acres of waterfront land in Milton, Florida to build the St. Stephen Retreat Center ("Retreat Center"), a facility that will accommodate up to 240 persons plus 50 nuns.

The Retreat Center will be used for youth and family conventions and will be managed by consecrated sisters (nuns). It will include a church, a convent for the consecrated sisters (nuns), 120 rooms accommodating 240 persons, a multipurpose hall, a dining hall, kitchen, and open seating for meditation, among other wonderful amenities.

The Retreat Center will be built in phases, the first of which will include the reception building, two dormitory buildings, the kitchen, and half of the a multipurpose hall and a dining area. The estimated cost for the whole project is \$15 million; the first phase alone will cost \$5 million.
