Leviticus:

Writer: Prophet Moses **Chapters:** 27 **Timeline:** ~ 1800 – 1400 B.C.

Main topics: The laws of the Priests (Levites), Worship Laws, Purification Laws, The Sacrifices, the Feasts

1Kings:

Writer: Prophet Jeremiah **Chapters:** 22 **Timeline:** ~ 600 B.C

Main topics: The history of the kingdom of Israel from Solomon to Ahab – King Solomon – the Temple – the division of the kingdom and the kings of the southern Kingdom (Judea) – the role of Prophet Elijah.

1Timothy:

Writer: St. Paul **Chapters:** 6 **Timeline:** ~ 64-65 A.D

Main topics: pastoral letter to advice Timothy of his responsibilities as a bishop, advices on worship, church and serving all the groups of the congregation (the priests, the widows, the young, the elders...etc)

2Timothy:

Writer: St. Paul **Chapters:** 4 **Timeline:** ~ 67-68 A.D

Main topics: being in the prison in Rome & and knowing that his martyrdom is near, he sent this letter as his final advices to preach and evangelize with the spirit of strength, struggle in service and resisting the heresies and the deceivers
